

## **STUDENTS ELECTIONS TO THE BOARD OF THE B.Sc. IN ENGINEERING SCIENCES**

The B.Sc. in Engineering Sciences calls an election for 4 students' representatives to be appointed to the Board.

Voting will take place online only. The first round of elections will take place on **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May from 01:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. local Italian time**. Should the first round be void, the second round will take place on **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May from 01:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. local Italian time**.

The active electorate is formed by students:

1. enrolled in the B.Sc. in Engineering Sciences, department of Industrial Engineering
2. who have fulfilled all tuition fees payments by the date of the first round of elections

The passive electorate is formed by students:

1. who have fulfilled all tuition fees payments by the deadline of the presentation of candidacies
2. enrolled in the B.Sc. in Engineering Sciences, department of Industrial Engineering
3. enrolled with no more than one extra year from their year of first enrolment

### **PRESENTATION OF CANDIDACIES**

Candidacies must be presented to the Administrative Office of the Department of Industrial Engineering via email to Daniela Pinto at [daniela.pinto@uniroma2.it](mailto:daniela.pinto@uniroma2.it) by **30/04/2021 at 11.59 p.m. local Italian time**. Candidates must submit a personal declaration which will be verified by the Administrative Staff.



## **VOTING METHOD**

Voters can give one single vote to candidates only. Votes given to people not included in the candidates' list will be counted as null. Should there be cases of homonymy among candidates, the Electoral Board will provide the date of birth for each candidate.
